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# Standards, CoP and GLs adopted, revoked or discontinued

- The thirty-fourth session of the *Codex Alimentarius Commission* (CAC) (4 July 2011 to 9 July 2011) in Geneva, Switzerland
- ~ 57 standards, Code of Practice (CoP) and Guidelines (GLs) adopted, revoked or discontinued



## Food Additives, Pesticide Residues and Veterinary Drug Residues in Food

#### Food Additives

Adopted many maximum levels (MLs) of about 10 food additives and revoked some MLs of 4 food additives

#### Pesticides Residues in Food

 Adopted about 320 new maximum residue limits (MRLs) of 25 pesticides and revoked about 80 existing MRLs of 13 pesticides

#### Veterinary Drugs Residues in Food

■ Adopted 12 new MRLs of 2 veterinary drugs

## Newly Adopted CoP for the Reduction of Ethyl Carbamate in Stone Fruit Distillates

Provide national and local authorities, manufacturers and other relevant bodies with guidance to prevent and/or reduce formation of ethyl carbamate in stone fruit distillates



## Food Microbiological Safety

Newly Adopted Guidelines for the Control of Campylobacter and Salmonella spp. in Chicken Meat

- Provide guidance to governments and industry on the control of *Campylobacter and Salmonella spp*. in chicken meat
- Apply to all steps in a "primary production-toconsumption" food chain for chicken meat production

# Food Microbiological Safety

Newly Adopted revision of the Recommended International Code of Hygiene Practice for Collecting, Processing and Marketing of Natural Mineral Waters

- Provide recommended hygienic practices for collecting natural mineral waters, their treatment, bottling, packaging, storage, transport, distribution and sale for direct consumption, to the government and industry
- Important issue: Revised microbiological criteria of the COP
- CFS is now working on revising the local microbiological guidelines for ready-to-eat food
- Consider to make reference to this CoP in the current revision of the local microbiological guidelines
