There was no mention of distribution in other places. • The local trade has been alerted. • Acquisition of the product through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded. • Consumers who are allergic to peanuts may develop hypersensitivity reactions, which can be life-threatening in severe cases, upon consumption of peanut-containing food. They are advised not to consume the product. • CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary.
