<b>Heading</b>	The US Food and Drug Administration (FDA) - Fairytale Brownies voluntarily recalls Peanut Butter Brownies and Cookies due to possible health risk
<b>The incident</b>	FDA issued a notice regarding a recall of peanut butter brownies and cookies in the US by Fairytale Brownies because they contain peanut butter supplied by Sunland, Inc., which may be contaminated with <i>Salmonella</i> .

<b>Position of CFS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• According to FDA, the products were distributed primarily through mail-order channel as well as some retail outlets.</li> <li>• The local trade has been alerted.</li> <li>• Acquisition of the products through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded.</li> <li>• <i>Salmonella</i> infection may cause fever and gastrointestinal upset such as abdominal pain and diarrhoea. People with lowered immunity such as infants and the elderly could present with more severe and even life-threatening infection.</li> <li>• Consumers should discard the product and not consume it.</li> <li>• CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary.</li> </ul>
