<b>Heading</b>	The US Food and Drug Administration (FDA) - Harry and David, LLC expands its voluntary recall of peanut butters, peanut spreads and related products due to potential health risk based on the expanded recall by Sunland, Inc. (Update)
<b>The incident</b>	FDA issued a notice regarding an expanded recall of Peanut Butters, Peanut Spreads and related products in the US by Harry and David, LLC in response to an expansion of Sunland, Inc's voluntary recall of products manufactured in its Peanut Butter Plant after March 1, 2010 due to possible contamination with <i>Salmonella</i> . The recalled peanut butter products were produced by Sunland, Inc.

<b>Position of CFS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>According to FDA, the products are distributed in the U.S.</li> <li>Acquisition of the products through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded.</li> <li><i>Salmonella</i> infection may cause fever and gastrointestinal upset such as abdominal pain and diarrhoea. People with lowered immunity such as infants and the elderly could present with more severe and even life-threatening infection.</li> <li>Consumers should discard the product and not consume it.</li> <li>CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary.</li> </ul>
