The incident	The Centre for Food Safety (CFS) received notification from the Rapid Alert System for Food and Feed of the European Commission (EC) that a kind of canned mackerel imported from Spain was found to contain glass fragments (1 x 0.5 cm) by the Italian authorities.

CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary
