<b>Heading</b>	The Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) - Certain BIRCH FARMS AND ESTATE WINERY brand PUMPKIN BUTTER may contain dangerous bacteria
<b>The incident</b>	CFIA issued a notice regarding the recall of certain BIRCH FARMS AND ESTATE WINERY brand PUMPKIN BUTTER in Canada by Birch Farms and Estate Winery in Canada because it may be contaminated with <i>Clostridium botulinum</i> .

<b>Position of CFS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• According to CFIA, the affected product was distributed in Ontario of Canada.</li> <li>• Acquisition of the products through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded.</li> <li>• The affected product may be contaminated with <i>Clostridium botulinum</i>. Ingestion of botulism toxin from the affected product may lead to serious illness and death. Symptoms of botulism include blurred or double vision, general weakness, poor reflexes, difficulty in swallowing and respiratory paralysis.</li> <li>• Consumers should discard the product and not consume it.</li> <li>• CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary.</li> </ul>
