<b>Heading</b>	Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) - Certain KROWN brand CHERRY TOMATOES and various STORE-MADE PARTY TRAYS containing CHERRY TOMATOES may contain <i>Salmonella</i> bacteria
<b>The incident</b>	CFIA issued a notice regarding a recall of certain Krown brand cherry tomatoes and various Store-made Party Trays containing cherry tomatoes in Canada, because the product may be contaminated with <i>Salmonella</i> .

<b>Position of CFS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• According to CFIA, the affected products were imported products and distributed in Canada.</li> <li>• The local trade has been alerted.</li> <li>• Acquisition of the products through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded.</li> <li>• <i>Salmonella</i> infection may cause fever and gastrointestinal upset such as abdominal pain and diarrhoea. People with lowered immunity such as infants and the elderly could present with more severe and even life-threatening infection.</li> <li>• Consumers should discard the product and not consume it.</li> <li>• CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary.</li> </ul>
