<b>Position of CFS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>According to US FDA, the product is available in some regions of US.</li> <li>Acquisition of the product through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded.</li> <li><i>Salmonella</i> infection may cause fever and gastrointestinal upset such as abdominal pain and diarrhoea. People with lowered immunity such as infants and the elderly could present with more severe and even life-threatening infection.</li> <li>Consumers should discard the product and not consume it.</li> <li>CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary.</li> </ul>
