The incident	CFIA issued a notice regarding an expanded recall of certain bulk in-shell filberts (hazelnuts) (product of USA) in Canada by Loblaw Companies Ltd. because the product may be contaminated with <i>Salmonella</i> .

Position of CFS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> According to CFIA, the affected product is a product of the U.S. and was distributed in Canada. Information about distribution in other places was not available. The local trade has been alerted. Acquisition of the products through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded. <i>Salmonella</i> infection may cause fever and gastrointestinal upset such as abdominal pain and diarrhoea. People with lowered immunity such as infants and the elderly could present with more severe and even life-threatening infection. Consumers should discard the product and not consume it. CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary.
