<b>The incident</b>	CFIA issued a notice regarding a recall on certain LifeForce Foods brand Sprouts in Canada by Canada Safeway Limited because the products may be contaminated with <i>Listeria monocytogenes</i> .

<b>Position of CFS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• According to CFIA, the affected products are products of the U.S. and have been distributed in British Columbia of Canada.</li> <li>• The local trade has been alerted.</li> <li>• Acquisition of the products through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded.</li> <li>• <i>Listeria monocytogenes</i> may pose health risk to exposed individuals, in particular pregnant women, newborns, the elderly and people with weak immunity who may present with severe infection including miscarriage and meningitis.</li> <li>• Consumers should discard the products and not consume them.</li> <li>• CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary.</li> </ul>
