<b>Heading</b>	Department of Livestock Services of Nepal notified the World Organization for Animal Health (OIE) on five confirmed Highly Pathogenic Notifiable Avian Influenza (HPNAI) H5N1 outbreak cases that started on 4.2.2013 and 5.2.2013.
<b>The incident</b>	5 HPNAI H5N1 outbreaks were reported in commercial broiler farms and backyard birds in Bagmati and Mechi of Nepal. All the outbreaks were resolved by 12.2.2013.
