Position of CFS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • According to FSAI, the affected product is a product of Ireland and has been distributed in certain regions of Ireland. • Acquisition of the products through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded. • The local trade has been alerted. • <i>E. coli</i> O157H:7 may cause symptoms like severe watery diarrhoea, bloody diarrhoea, fever, abdominal cramps or vomiting. Severe cases may develop haemolytic uraemic syndrome (HUS) characterised by acute kidney failure, and some may even die. • Consumers should discard the products and not consume them. • CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary.
