Position of CFS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• According to FSANZ, the affected products are products of Australia and have been distributed in certain regions of Australia.</li> <li>• Acquisition of the products through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded.</li> <li>• The presence of <i>E. coli</i> in food generally indicates direct or indirect faecal contamination. Substantial number of <i>E. coli</i> in food suggests a general lack of cleanliness in handling and improper storage and implies a certain risk that it may be present.</li> <li>• Consumers should discard the products and not consume them.</li> <li>• CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary.</li> </ul>
