Position of CFS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> According to CFIA, the affected product has been distributed in certain regions of Canada. Acquisition of the product through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded. The affected product may be contaminated with <i>Clostridium botulinum</i>. Ingestion of botulism toxin from the affected product may lead to serious illness and death. Symptoms of botulism include blurred or double vision, general weakness, poor reflexes, difficulty in swallowing and respiratory paralysis. Consumers should discard the products and not consume them. CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary
