Information on product distribution outside Australia is not available from the FSANZ website. The local trade has been alerted. Acquisition of the product through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded. Consumers who are allergic to egg may develop hypersensitivity reactions, which can be life-threatening in severe cases, upon consumption of food containing egg. They are advised not to consume the products. CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary
