Information on product distribution outside Australia is not available from FSANZ website. • The local trade has been alerted. • Acquisition of the products through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded. • <i>Listeria monocytogenes</i> may pose health risk to exposed individuals, in particular pregnant women, newborns, the elderly and people with weak immunity who may present with severe infection including miscarriage and meningitis. • Consumers should discard the products and not consume them. • CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary.
