Position of CFS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> According to FDA, the affected product was imported from Turkey. Information on product distribution outside the U.S. is not available from FDA website. The local trade has been alerted. Acquisition of the products through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded. Hepatitis A is a contagious liver disease that results from exposure to the hepatitis A virus, including from food. Symptoms of the illness include sudden onset of fever, malaise, nausea, anorexia, and abdominal discomfort, followed in several days by jaundice. Consumers should discard the product and not consume it. CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary
