<b>Heading</b>	The US Food and Drug Administration (FDA) – Baltic Treasures, Norwegian Style Matjes, Marinella "Delicatessnaya", Jewish Style Matjes, Traditional Russian Matjes, and Rybacka Wies Matjes Brands of Herring Fillets in Oil may contain <i>Listeria monocytogenes</i>
<b>The incident</b>	FDA issued a notice regarding a recall of Baltic Treasures, Norwegian Style Matjes, Marinella "Delicatessnaya", Jewish Style Matjes, Traditional Russian Matjes, and Rybacka Wies Matjes Brands of Herring Fillets in Oil in the US by Gold Star Smoked Fish Corp. because the product may be contaminated with <i>Listeria monocytogenes</i>

Information on product distribution outside the US is not available from FDA website.</li> <li>• The local trade has been alerted.</li> <li>• Acquisition of the products through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded.</li> <li>• <i>Listeria monocytogenes</i> may pose health risk to exposed individuals, in particular pregnant women, newborns, the elderly and people with weak immunity who may present with severe infection including miscarriage and meningitis.</li> <li>• Consumers should discard the products and not consume them.</li> <li>• CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary.</li> </ul>
