Heading	The Ministry for Primary Industries of New Zealand (MPI) – Recall of Nutricia formula products that may have been contaminated with <i>Clostridium botulinum</i> . (update)
The incident	<p>The MPI issued an updated notice on the recalled Nutricia Infant formulae that may have been contaminated with <i>Clostridium botulinum</i>. The recalled products are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Nutricia Karicare Stage 1 Infant Formula (0-6 months), produced between 21 May 2013 and 2 August 2013 inclusive. ▪ Nutricia Karicare Gold+ Stage 2 Follow-on Formula (from 6 months), produced between 21 May 2013 and 2 August 2013 inclusive.

Position of CFS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • According to the MPI, the above information applies to New Zealand consumers only. • Acquisition of the products through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded. • <i>Clostridium botulinum</i> may pose health risk to exposed individuals, in particular infants under one-year-old and immunocompromised adults, those using antimicrobials, or those with bowel abnormalities. Patients with intestinal botulism may present with constipation and poor feeding. • Consumers should discard the products and not consume them. • CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary.
