Position of CFS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> According to FSANZ, the affected product is a product of Australia and has been distributed in certain regions of Australia. Information on product distribution outside Australia is not available from FSANZ website. Acquisition of the products through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded. <i>Listeria monocytogenes</i> may pose health risk to exposed individuals, in particular pregnant women, newborns, the elderly and people with weak immunity who may present with severe infection including miscarriage and meningitis. Consumers should discard the products and not consume them. CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary.
