<b>Position of CFS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Information on product distribution outside Ireland is not available from FSAI website.</li> <li>The local trade has been alerted.</li> <li>Acquisition of the products through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded.</li> <li>Consumers who are allergic to peanut may develop hypersensitivity reactions, which can be life-threatening in severe cases, upon consumption of food containing peanut. They are advised not to consume the products.</li> <li>CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary</li> </ul>
