Position of CFS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Information on product distribution outside the U.K. is not available from FSA website. The local trade has been alerted. Acquisition of the products through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded. <i>E. coli</i> O157H:7 may cause symptoms like severe watery diarrhoea, bloody diarrhoea, fever, abdominal cramps or vomiting. Severe cases may develop haemolytic uraemic syndrome (HUS) characterised by acute kidney failure, and some may even die. Consumers should discard the products and not consume them. CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary.
