Information on product distribution outside Canada is not available from the CFIA website. The local trade has been alerted. Acquisition of the product through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded. Consumers who are allergic to almonds may develop hypersensitivity reactions, which can be life-threatening in severe cases, upon consumption of food containing almonds. They are advised not to consume the product. CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary.
