Position of CFS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> According to FDA, the affected product has been distributed in certain regions of the U.S. Information on product distribution outside the U.S. is not available from FDA website. The local trade has been alerted. Acquisition of the product through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded. Short term exposure to high levels of lead can cause abdominal pain, vomiting and anaemia, whereas chronic low-level exposure can cause retarded cognitive and intellectual development in children. Infant, young children and foetus are more sensitive to toxic effects of lead, especially in regard to the damages to their central nervous system. Consumers should discard the product and not consume them. CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary.
