Position of CFS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - There were no poultry meat or poultry products imported from Libya in the past three years. No import protocol for poultry meat and poultry products has been established between Hong Kong and Libya. Therefore, CFS has no intention to impose any import suspension on the aforementioned commodities at this stage. - Imported poultry meat and meat products must be accompanied with valid certificate attesting that the meat or meat products are derived from poultry which have been kept and slaughtered from NAI free countries, zones or compartments according to an established import protocol. - CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary.
