Position of CFS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Information on product distribution outside the Canada is not available from the CFIA websites. Preliminary investigation so far does not identify local sale of the affected products. CFS is contacting the US authority for further information. Acquisition of the products through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded. <i>Salmonella</i> infection may cause fever and gastrointestinal upset such as abdominal pain and diarrhea. People with lowered immunity such as infants and the elderly could present with more severe and even life-threatening infection. Consumers should discard the products and not consume them. CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary.
