<b>Heading</b>	<p>The U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA)– Recall of certain frozen vegetables and products containing sunflower seeds/ kernels in US and Canada due to possible contamination with <i>Listeria monocytogenes</i>.</p>
<b>The incident</b>	<p>The FDA and CFIA issued notices regarding recalls of certain frozen vegetables and products containing sunflower seeds/ kernels by different companies because the products may be contaminated with <i>Listeria monocytogenes</i>. These included</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(1) Harris Teeter Frozen Organic Corn and Harris Teeter Frozen Mixed Vegetables by Harris Teeter.</li> <li>(2) Certain frozen vegetables and Kroger Brand Frozen Vegetables by Pictsweet Company</li> <li>(3) Various frozen food items by Ajinomoto Windsor, Inc.</li> <li>(4) Frozen Organic Peas and Mixed Vegetables by Twin City Foods, Inc.</li> <li>(5) Cut Green Beans by Stahlbush Island Farms, Inc.</li> <li>(6) Sweet and Salty Trail Mix by Rucker's Wholesale and Service Co.</li> <li>(7) Kroger Broccoli Raisin Salad by Kroger Co.</li> <li>(8) Ajinomoto brand Yakitori Chicken with Japanese-Style Fried Rice by Costco Wholesale Canada Ltd.</li> </ol> <p>Details of products being recalled are listed in the FDA and CFIA websites.</p>

CFS is investigating whether the affected batches have been imported to Hong Kong and is contacting the U.S. authority for further information.</li> <li>• Acquisition of the products through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded.</li> <li>• Consumers should discard the products and not consume them.</li> <li>• CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary.</li> <li>• Investigation by CFS is ongoing.</li> <li>• Listeriosis is usually caused by eating food contaminated with Listeria which can be easily destroyed by cooking but can survive and multiply at refrigerator temperatures.
