Heading	The U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA)– Recall of four specific flavors of Nature Valley Protein Chewy Bars and Nature Valley Simple Nut Bars in US due to potential presence of <i>Listeria monocytogenes</i> .
The incident	<p>The FDA issued a notice regarding a recall of four specific flavors of Nature Valley Protein Chewy Bars and Nature Valley Simple Nut Bars by General Mills in the U.S. in which they are related to the sunflower kernel supplier SunOpta's ongoing national recall for the potential presence of <i>Listeria monocytogenes</i>.</p> <p>Details of products being recalled are listed in the FDA website.</p>

Position of CFS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Information on product distribution outside the US is not available from the FDA website. CFS is investigating whether the affected batches have been imported to Hong Kong and is contacting the U.S. authority for further information. Preliminary investigation so far does not identify local sale of the affected batches. Acquisition of the products through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded. Listeriosis is usually caused by eating food contaminated with <i>Listeria</i> which can be easily destroyed by cooking but can survive and multiply at refrigerator temperatures. Severe complications may occur, such as septicaemia, meningitis or even death in newborns, elderly and those with weaker immune systems; and miscarriages during pregnancy. Consumers should discard the products and not consume them. CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary. Investigation by CFS is ongoing.
