Intestinal bleeding and serious complications such as hemolytic uraemic syndrome (HUS) may also develop in some people. Moreover, due to poor personal hygiene, person-to-person transmission of this pathogen is possible through oral-faecal route. <i>E. coli</i> cannot survive under high temperature and can be killed by thorough cooking.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Public is advised not to eat/ taste raw dough or batter.• Consumers should discard the products and not consume them.• CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary.• Investigation by CFS is ongoing.
