The incident

The FSA issued a notice regarding a recall of a specific batch of Lanark White cheese in Scotland by Errington Cheese Ltd because the product may contain *E.coli O157* bacteria.

Recalled Products

- The product in question is Lanark White, a white cheese made from unpasteurised sheep's milk, produced by Errington Cheese Ltd that consumers may have purchased between 22 August 2016 and 10 September 2016.

Position of CFS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Information on product distribution outside U.K. is not available from the FSA website. CFS is investigating whether the affected batch has been imported to Hong Kong and is contacting the U.K. authority for further information. Acquisition of the products through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded. Consumers should discard the products and not consume them. People contract <i>E. coli</i>, which is a gastro-intestinal infection, through consumption of contaminated water or undercooked and contaminated foods. Intestinal bleeding and serious complications such as hemolytic uraemic syndrome (HUS) may also develop in some people. Moreover, due to poor personal hygiene, person-to-person transmission of this pathogen is possible through oral-faecal route. <i>E. coli</i> cannot survive under high temperature and can be killed by thorough cooking. CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary.

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- Investigation by CFS is ongoing.
