<b>Heading</b>	The Food Safety Agency (FSA) of UK issued a notice regarding a recall of certain Hilltop Honey - Raw British Creamed Honey in the UK by Hilltop Honey due to possible presence of small pieces of metal
<b>The incident</b>	<p>The FSA of UK issued a notice regarding a recall of five batches of Raw British Creamed Honey produced by Hilltop Honey on a precautionary basis due to small pieces of metal being found in the product. The company has advised that the product should not be consumed.</p> <p><b><u>Recalled products</u></b></p> <p>Product: Hilltop Honey - Raw British Creamed Honey  Pack size: 340g glass jars  Batch code: Batches with EXP dates of: 16/04/2017, 29/05/2018, 11/06/2018, 14/06/2018, 18/06/2018.</p> <p>Details of products being recalled are listed in the FSA website.</p>
