<b>Heading</b>	The Food Safety and Inspection Service (FSIS) of U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) issued a notice regarding Kraft Heinz recalls Ready-To-Eat Lunchables Ham and American Cracker Stackers product due to misbranding and undeclared allergens
<b>The incident</b>	<p>Kraft Heinz Company, a Fullerton, Calif. establishment, is recalling approximately 959 pounds of ready-to-eat "Lunchables Ham and American Cracker Stackers" packaged lunch products due to misbranding and undeclared allergens in the U.S. . The product contains wheat and soy, known allergens, which are not declared on the product label.</p> <p>The products being recalled are listed in the FSIS website.</p>

CFS is investigating whether the affected batches have been imported to Hong Kong.</li> <li>Acquisition of the products through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded.</li> <li>People who have an allergy or severe sensitivity to the said allergens should not consume the concerned products as there is risk of a serious or life threatening allergic reaction if they consume it.</li> <li>People should seek medical treatment if they feel unwell after consuming.</li> <li>CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary.</li> </ul>
