CFS is investigating whether the affected batches have been imported to Hong Kong. Acquisition of the products through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded. Consumers should discard the products and not consume them. CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary. Investigation by CFS is ongoing. According to FSA, the sterility of the batches listed has been compromised. As a result the microbiological safety of these
