Position of CFS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Information on product distribution outside the U.K. is not available from the FSA website. CFS is investigating whether the affected batches have been imported to Hong Kong. Preliminary investigation so far does not identify local sale of the affected products. Investigation by CFS is ongoing. Consumers who are allergic to hazelnut should discard the products and not consume them. People who are allergic to hazelnuts may have immunologic response like vomiting, diarrhoea and rash upon consumption of food containing this allergen. In severe cases, anaphylactic shock may even develop. As for other members of the public, generally speaking, they would not be subject to such reactions when the food in question is consumed. CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary.
