The incident	The U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) issued a notice regarding a recall of Protein Bars products in the U.S. by Bhu Foods due to potential <i>Listeria monocytogenes</i> contamination of organic sunflower seeds ingredients.	
	According to Bhu Foods, the organic sunflower seeds in the recalled products were from Hudson Valley Foods, Inc which has the potential <i>Listeria monocytogenes</i> contamination.	
	Bhu Foods is recalling the following flavors of Protein bars produced from May 9, 2017 – June 9, 2017 which was available nationwide in retail stores in U.S. as well as by mail order/direct delivery.:

Severe complications may occur, such as septicaemia, meningitis or even death in newborns, elderly and those with weaker immune systems; and miscarriages during pregnancy.</li> </ul>
