Position of CFS

- CFS is investigating whether the affected batches have been imported to Hong Kong. Preliminary investigation so far identified one importer, Culina (H.K.) Ltd, had imported some affected products and sold to a restaurant. In its follow-up investigation with the restaurant concerned, the Centre learnt that the affected product has not been used and will be returned to the importer for disposal according to the CFS' instructions.
- Investigation by CFS is ongoing.
- Salmonella infection may cause fever and gastrointestinal upset such as abdominal pain and diarrhea. People with lowered immunity such as infants and the elderly could present with more severe and even life-threatening infection.
- Consumers should discard the products and not consume them.
- People should seek medical treatment if they fell unwell after consuming.
- CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development
