### **Background**

 "Guidelines on Food Classification for the Pesticide Residues in Food Regulation" (the Guidelines) is intended to facilitate the trade in identifying the appropriate pesticide residue limits that are relevant to the food commodities concerned. The Guidelines is prepared by making reference to the Codex Classification of Foods and Animal Feeds.





## Background (con'd)

The Guidelines is provided for information only. It does not have the force of law and should not be interpreted in any manner which would override the provision of the Pesticide Residues in Food Regulation ("the Regulation", Cap. 132CM). In case of any inconsistency, the statutory provisions will prevail.

- The Regulation has comes into operation since 1 August 2014.
- The Centre for Food Safety (CFS) is revising the Guidelines.
