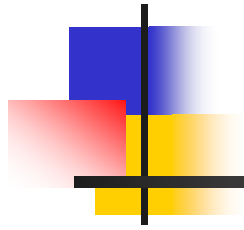
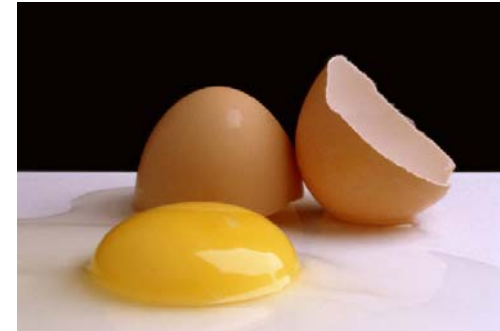


Proposed Regulation of Imported Poultry Eggs



In 2014, about 2.2 billion poultry eggs were imported to Hong Kong

Mainland China	(53%)
USA	(23%)
Thailand	(10%)
Malaysia	(7%)
Ukraine	(2%)
Others	(5%)





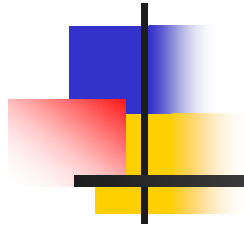
Need for Regulatory Control

- Threat of avian influenza outbreak
- World Organization for Animal Health (OIE) recommended imported poultry eggs to be accompanied with health certificate



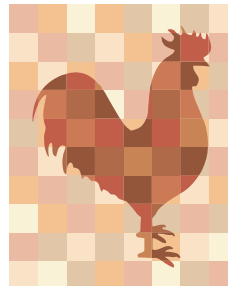
Consultation

- Consultation forums with the trade on regulation of poultry eggs were conducted in 2007, 2010 and 2011
- The proposal was well received



The Proposed Regulation

To amend the Imported Game, Meat and Poultry Regulations (Chapter 132AK) to regulate the import of eggs





The Proposed Regulation

Scope of Regulation:

- (i) table eggs or their edible parts,
- (ii) salted, preserved or otherwise processed eggs or their edible parts,
- (iii) liquid egg;
- (iv) frozen egg; and
- (v) dried egg

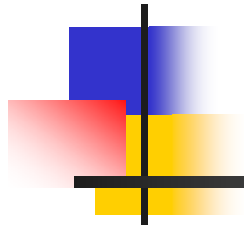
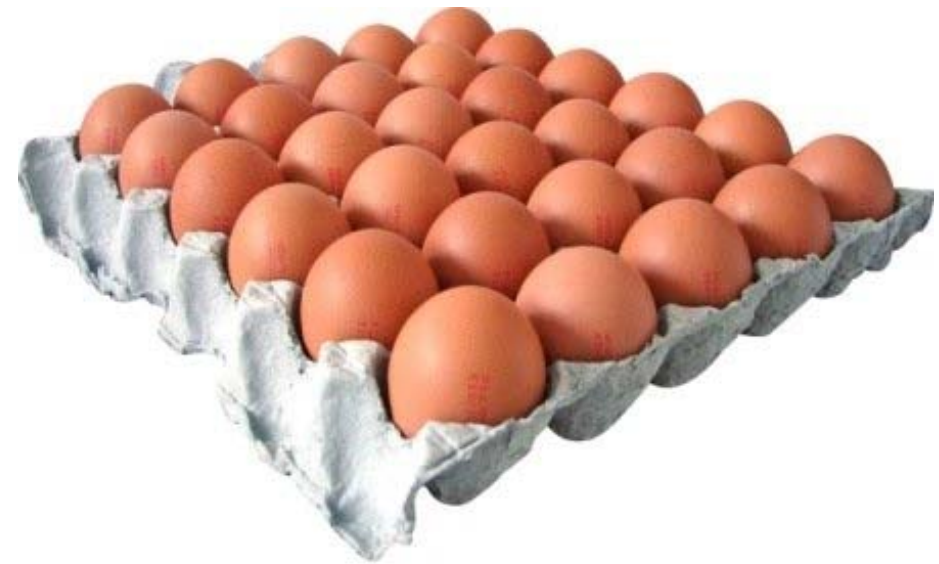
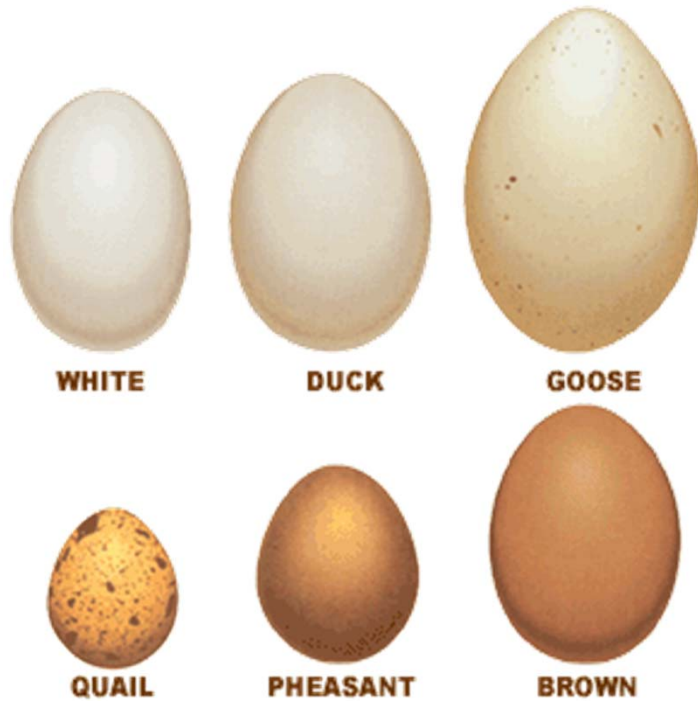


Table Eggs

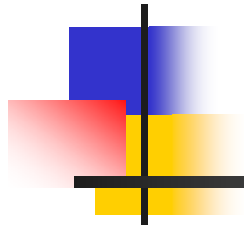
Dried Egg/Egg Mix





The Proposed Regulation

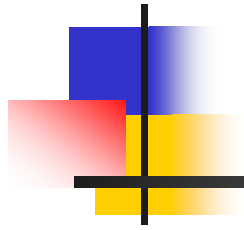
- Prior written permission from FEHD is required for import of eggs
- Every consignment of eggs to be accompanied with health certificate issued by relevant authority of the exporting country or place attesting to their fitness for human consumption
