

Advance Release Arrangement for Hong Kong-manufactured Food Products Entering the Mainland Market



Background

- ◆ The Environment and Ecology Bureau and the General Administration of Customs of the People's Republic of China (GACC) signed "the Cooperation Agreement on the Supervision of Safety and Facilitation of Customs Clearance of Food Products Manufactured in Hong Kong Exported to the Mainland" on 27 November 2023, for shortening the time required for customs clearance, further enhancing the safety of local food products exported to the Mainland and promoting trade facilitation
- ◆ Advance Release Arrangement has been rolled out on 21 May 2024
- ◆ Food products required to be tested by the Mainland Customs can be released upon completion of sampling without the need to wait for the results

Applicable Categories of Hong Kong-manufactured Food

- ◆ Beverages and frozen drinks (excluding alcoholic and milk beverages)
- ◆ Biscuits, pastries and bread
- ◆ Candies and chocolates (including chocolate, cocoa butter substitute chocolate and their products)
- ◆ Noodles (without meat ingredient)
- ◆ Seasoning (ground)
- ◆ Tea

Ports for Implementation

- ◆ Shenzhen Customs Port
- ◆ Gongbei Customs Port
- ◆ Huangpu Customs Port

Assessment Criteria for “Advance Release Permission”

- ◆ Holding a valid Food Factory Licence issued by FEHD
- ◆ Food products must be manufactured in the food factory stated in the aforesaid Food Factory Licence
- ◆ A food safety management system with relevant certification (i.e. ISO 22000 or HACCP certification) must be in place in the food factory concerned
- ◆ The food products concerned must comply with the national standards and laws

Operational Procedures of Advance Release Arrangement

1

- Food manufacturers apply for “Advance Release Permission” with the Center for Food Safety (CFS) through online application or by paper-mode application

2

- The CFS conducts preliminary assessment and accepts the application if basic criteria has been complied with

3

- Food manufacturers submit application documents, including test certificate with relevant test reports issued within the last six months by a recognized third-party institute

4

- The CFS issues "Advance Release Permission" to food manufacturers after confirmation of compliance with all requirements

Operational Procedures of Advance Release Arrangement

5

- Food Manufacturers make use of “Advance Release Permission” to apply for “Health Certificate for Foods of Animal Origin” or “Food Inspection Certificate” from the CFS for **each food consignment**

6

- The CFS issues “Health Certificate for Foods of Animal Origin” or “Food Inspection Certificate” to the food manufacturers

7

- Food manufacturers conduct customs declaration and clearance of the food (must be accompanied by relevant certificates , including the “Certificate of Hong Kong Origin-CEPA”)
- If the food is subject to sampling by the Mainland Customs, it can be released directly after sampling

Customs Clearance at the Ports of Mainland Through Advance Release Arrangement

- ◆ Mainland customs conduct inspection and sampling to the food products
- ◆ After satisfactory inspection & sampling, food products can be released without the need to wait for the results

Note for Attention

- ◆ Food Manufacturers must ensure that the relevant food factory has been registered with the GACC before import of the food products to the Mainland.

Food Inspection Certificate and Certified True Copy of Food Inspection Certificate

- ◆ After the “Advance Release Permission” is issued, food manufacturers should apply for a “Food Inspection Certificate” for each consignment of the food product.
- ◆ Food manufacturers can apply for an official certified true copy of the “Food Inspection Certificate” (“CTC”).
- ◆ Food products in the same production period can be exported to the same consignee in the Mainland in separate consignments using the CTCs.

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Advance Release Arrangement for Hong Kong-Manufactured Food Products Entering the Mainland Market

The Environment and Ecology Bureau and the General Administration of Customs of the People's Republic of China (GACC) signed the Cooperation Agreement on the Supervision of Safety and Facilitation of Customs Clearance of Food Products Manufactured in Hong Kong Exported to the Mainland (Cooperation Agreement) on 27 November 2023, establishing Advance Release Arrangement for eligible Hong Kong Manufactured food products to shorten the time for customs clearance.

Cooperation Framework

According to the Cooperation Agreement, the Centre for Food Safety (CFS) and the GACC will start cooperation on safety supervision and the facilitation of customs clearance of food products manufactured in Hong Kong exported to Mainland. The CFS will conduct supervision on Hong Kong-manufactured food products exported to the Mainland to ensure compliance with the Mainland requirements while food products required to be tested by Mainland Customs can be released upon completion of sampling without waiting for the results.

The Advance Release Arrangement will initially cover three major categories of food, namely (1) beverages and frozen drinks (excluding alcoholic and milk beverages); (2) biscuits, pastries and bread; and (3) candies and chocolates (including chocolate, cocoa butter substitute chocolate and their products). The arrangement will be available at the ports under Shenzhen Customs, Gongbei Customs and Huangpu Customs.

Food Classification is based on Chinese HS code and Inspection and Quarantine (CIQ) code. Please refer to [Table 1 \[Chinese version only\]](#) or the codes of the above three food categories.

Operational Procedures for Advance Release Arrangement

Food manufacturers who intend to participate the Advance Release Arrangement have to apply for "Advance Release Permission" for each category of the food products with the CFS to assess whether the manufacturer and its food
