

Lifting import ban on poultry and poultry products from South Africa except **Western Cape Province and Eastern Cape Province**

According to the information from the Department of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries, the Avian Influenza incidents in South Africa **except Western Cape Province and Eastern Cape Province** have been resolved. The Centre for Food Safety has lifted the import ban on poultry and poultry products (including poultry eggs) from South Africa **except Western Cape Province and Eastern Cape Province** with effect from 22 March 2016.
