

Lifting import ban on poultry and poultry products from State of Nebraska except
Dixon County, US

According to the information from the United States Department of Agriculture, the earlier emergency declaration because of Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza incident in State of Nebraska has been lifted. The Centre for Food Safety has thus lifted the import ban on poultry and poultry products (including poultry eggs) from State of Nebraska, US with effect from 2 July 2015.

However, the import suspension of poultry and poultry products including eggs for human consumption from the Dixon County in State of Nebraska is still maintained until further notice.
