

Lifting the country-wide ban of import of poultry and poultry products from the Netherlands

As there is no further spreading or new cases of the disease in the country since the last outbreak in Zoeterwoude, Municipality, the Centre for Food Safety has lifted the county-wide ban of import of poultry and poultry products (including poultry eggs) from the Netherlands since 22 January 2015.

However, the import suspension of poultry and poultry products including eggs for human consumption from the Provinces of Utrecht, Overijssel and South Holland are still maintained until further notice.
