

Lifting import ban on poultry and poultry products from Aomori, Niigata, Hokkaido, Kumamoto and Gifu Prefectures, Japan

The Avian Influenza incidents in Aomori, Niigata, Hokkaido, Kumamoto and Gifu Prefectures, Japan have been resolved. The Centre for Food Safety has lifted the import ban on poultry and poultry products (including poultry eggs) from Aomori, Niigata, Hokkaido, Kumamoto and Gifu Prefectures, Japan with effect from 18 April 2017.
