

Revision on Import Requirements for Chilled and Frozen Poultry from the Mainland

Subsequent to the agreement with the Mainland authority, the revision on import requirements for chilled and frozen poultry from the Mainland has been effected on 5.9.2017. The revision mainly covers the following:

- (i) removal of the requirement for having a fade-proof red-coloured stamp underneath chilled chicken wing.
- (ii) removal of the requirement for putting anti-fake label of respective Entry-Exit Inspection and Quarantine Bureau (CIQ) on packing of chilled poultry.
- (iii) allowing import of chilled and frozen quail from the Mainland;
- (iv) resuming import of chilled and frozen poultry offal from the Mainland.
