

Resumption of import into Hong Kong food products produced by Hebei Superb Foods Company Limited in Mainland China

Considering Husi Food Company Limited (Husi) in Mainland China was suspected to have food safety concern in 2014, the Centre for Food Safety (CFS) had suspended the import into Hong Kong all food products produced by all processing plants of Husi with effect from 24 July 2014.

Last year, the Mainland authority requested the CFS to lift the suspension of import into Hong Kong food products produced by one of the Husi's processing plants, Hebei Superb Foods Company Limited, and provided the CFS with information on measures adopted by the processing plant on food safety and in monitoring the use of raw materials. After examining the provided information and conducting on-site inspection, the CFS agree to resume the import into Hong Kong food products produced by Hebei Superb Foods Company Limited with effect from 19 June 2019. However, the CFS maintain to suspend the import into Hong Kong all food products produced by other Husi's processing plants.
