

Lifting Import Suspension on Poultry and Poultry Products from the County Wicklow of Ireland

The Avian Influenza incident in the County Wicklow of Ireland has been resolved. The Centre for Food Safety has lifted the import suspension on poultry and poultry products (including poultry eggs) from the County Wicklow of Ireland with effect from 21 March 2022.
