

Lifting Import Suspension on Poultry and Poultry Products from the 5 AI-affected regions in the Northern Ireland, United Kingdom

The Avian Influenza incidents at the listed 5 AI-affected regions in the Northern Ireland, United Kingdom have been resolved. The Centre for Food Safety has lifted the import suspension on poultry and poultry products (including poultry eggs) from the listed 5 AI-affected regions in the Northern Ireland, United Kingdom with effect from 10 July 2023.
