

Lifting Import Suspension on Poultry
and Poultry Products from areas in United Kingdom

The Avian Influenza incident in Mountjoy Townland Area, Lisnaskea Townland Area, Pomeroy Townland Area and Bangor Townland Area in Northern Ireland of the United Kingdom has been resolved. The Centre for Food Safety has lifted the import suspension on poultry and poultry products (including poultry eggs) from the aforesaid Townland Areas in Northern Ireland of the United Kingdom with effect from 3 March 2026.
