

Lifting Import Suspension on Poultry and Poultry Products from South Korea

The Avian Influenza incident in the Gwangju, Yeongdong-gun, Jincheon-gun, Okcheon-gun, Jeungpyeong-gun, Goesan-gun, Eumseong-gun and Chungju-si of Chungcheongbuk-do Province, Hwaseong-si, Anseong-si, Pyeongtaek-si and Pocheon-si of Gyeonggi-do Province, Gochang-gun, Namwon-si, Jangsu-gun, Gimje-si and Iksan-si of Jeollabuk-do Province, Cheonan-si, Dangjin-si, Boryeong-si, Yesan-gun, Asan-si and Nonsan-si of Chungcheongnam-do Province, Gokseong-gun, Yeongam-gun, Naju-si, Gurye-gun and Muan-gun of Jeollanam-do Province, Sejong-si, Geochang-gun of Gyeongsangnam-do Province, Seongju-gun and Bonghwa-gun of Gyeongsangbuk-do Province in the South Korea has been resolved. The Centre for Food Safety has lifted the import suspension on poultry and poultry products (including poultry eggs) from the aforesaid Counties and Districts in the South Korea with effect from 8 July 2026.
