

Lifting Import Suspension on Poultry and Poultry Products from areas in Poland

The Avian Influenza incident in Legnica district of the Dolnośląskie region; Brodnica district, Bydgoszcz district, Chełmno district, Golub-Dobrzyń district, Inowrocław district, Lipno district and Żnin district of the Kujawsko-Pomorskie region; Brzeziny district, Poddębice district, Sieradz district and Zgierz district of the Łódzkie region; Bialski district, Parczewski district and Radzyński district of the Lubelskie region; Gorzów district, Międzyrzecz district, Sulęcín district, Świebodzin district and Żagań district of the Lubuskie region; Białobrzegi district, Gostynin district, Mława district, Płock district, Płońsk district, Sierpc district and Żuromin district of the Mazowieckie region; Namysłów district of the Opolskie region; Hajnówka district of the Podlaskie region; Kartuzy district and Słupsk district of the Pomorskie region; Pszczyna district of the Śląskie region; Bartoszyce district, Działdowo district, Giżycko district, Iława district, Kętrzyn district, Nidzica district, Nowe Miasto district, Olsztyn district, Ostróda district and Węgorzewo district of the Warmińsko-Mazurskie region; Chodzież district, Jarocin district, Kalisz district, Konin district, Leszno district, Nowy Tomyśl district, Ostrów Wielkopolski district, Ostrzeszowski district, Pleszewski district, Poznań district, Środa Wielkopolska district, Śrem district, Turek district and Wolsztyński district of the Wielkopolskie region and Stargard district of the Zachodniopomorskie region in Poland has been resolved. The Centre for Food Safety has lifted the import suspension on poultry and poultry products (including poultry eggs) from the aforesaid districts in Poland with effect from 14 August 2026.
